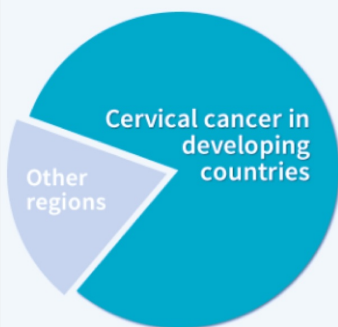
Volunteer OB/Gyn Plays Recruiter!
