# **MOBILE HEALTH** FOR MAMAS

### Community-Based Human Papillomavirus (HPV) **Testing and Treatment**

Our Community-Based HPV Testing and Treatment program, *Mobile Health* for Mamas, has redefined how cervical cancer screening and treatment services are delivered in remote and underserved communities.



### What We Do

### **TEST**



Human papillomavirus (HPV) testing identifies women with highrisk HPV, which causes over 99% of cervical cancer. Women can collect their own sample.

### TREAT



Thermal ablation treatment prevents cervical cancer from developing. This simple and painless procedure takes less than a minute and can be performed in a mobile clinic setting.

### LINK



In limited-resource settings, cancer treatment is often prohibitively expensive and scarcely available. We provide patient navigation services for women with advanced disease to bridge those gaps.

Education is the first step. Trained **Community Health** Workers educate men and women about cervical cancer screening, dispelling fear and stigma.

## How We Do It

Here's how we bring life-saving care to the last mile:

> Self-Sample **HPV** Testing

### Home-Based **HPV** Testing

Trained Community Health Workers bring self-sample HPV test kits directly to the doorsteps of eligible women in their communities. Women collect their own sample in the privacy of their home.

Samples are processed in our mobile laboratory and women are notified of their result.

### **Mobile Treatment**

Women who test positive for high-risk HPV receive preventative treatment at a mobile outreach in their community.



### Mobile Outreach-Based HPV Testing

In communities where home-based testing is not possible, women can collect their selfsamples at a mobile outreach in a pop-up privacy pod.

# **DEAR FRIENDS** AND SUPPORTERS

## Thanks to you, we accomplished big things in 2023,

including the completion of our new mobile laboratory and establishing CureCervicalCancer Kenya, our affiliate Kenyan NGO.

In addition to achieving these milestones, we've worked hard to refine our first-of-a-kind HPV Testing and Treatment program, Mobile Health for Mamas. We 10x'd the number of women we can test in one day by perfecting our community outreach strategy. We increased the percentage of women opting in for treatment from 50% to 85%. We expanded our support for women requiring higherlevel care, including covering transportation costs for appointments and linking women with Kenya's National Health Insurance Fund. Most importantly, we placed the needs and feedback of the women we serve front and center every step of the way–building not only a better program, but trust within the communities where we work.

That's how we've reached nearly 20,000 women with HPV testing and treatment.



As we pause to reflect on how far we've come, we are reminded of just how far we are able to go with your support. Together, we've taken Mobile Health for Mamas from an ambitious dream to a proven model—which we are now eager to replicate and scale to new regions in Kenya and beyond.

Growing our impact means bringing life-saving care to more of the women who need it most. Will you join us to make sure every woman has access to the care she deserves?




